Fishery Managers Message: During the recent work parties, more heavy and waste line was found around the fishery. You are reminded that line over 10 pounds (breaking strain) is not permitted and that you are required to remove all waste from your swim; we have a bin for waste line located in the toilet that will be sent for recycling.

Members using the white plastic garden chairs that are normally situated by the container, please return them to that area after use; this makes it easier for other members to locate them if necessary. This will also prevent them from falling into the Dell during high winds.

Additional corrugated sheeting has been used to support the island until additional planting can be completed to prevent further erosion. Work is currently being undertaken on the pathway between peg 30 and the dam to address the undercutting and reduce the risk of water draining away from the lake.

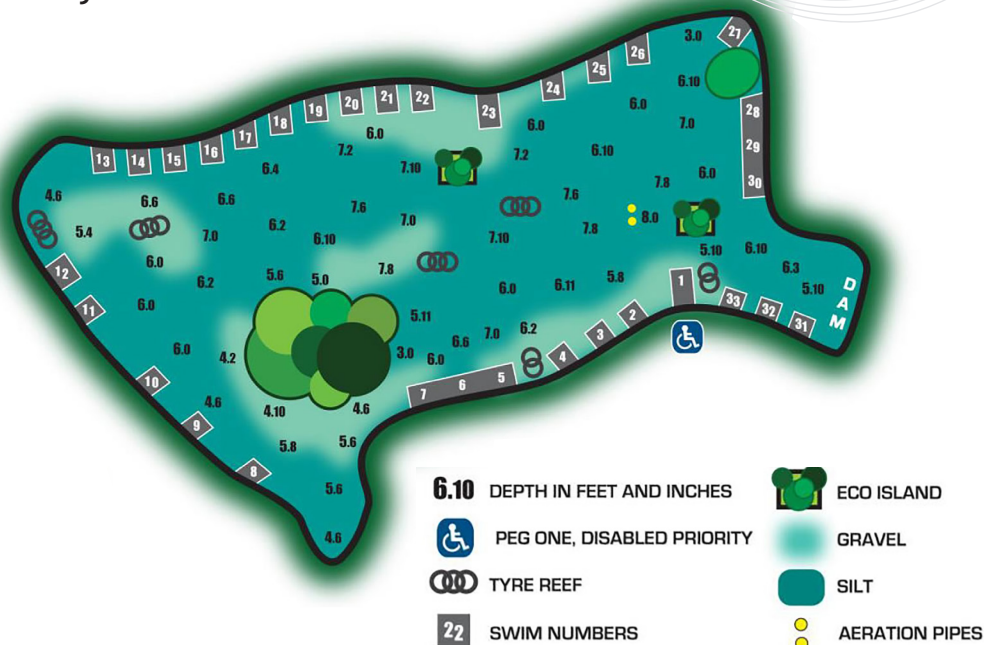
